

## **FUJIFILM DONATES DIGITAL CAMERAS TO PARKS VIA FRIENDS**

Capturing the essence and the beauty of Westchester's 18,000 acres of county parkland just got a lot easier, thanks to a donation of 24 digital cameras by Fujifilm to the Friends of Westchester County Parks.

“Having digital cameras in the hands of superintendents of key parks is a tremendous help to us in documenting our ‘living history,’ as well as providing photos we can use to help market our many services,” County Parks Commissioner Joseph A. Stout said that parks staff will also use the cameras to self-evaluate operations within their facilities, to track progress of construction projects, to document damage from storms and other incidents and to create “teachable moments” for training purposes.
